Summary

Gale Holtz Golden is a clinical social worker and clinical sexologist in full time private practice, and clinical associate professor of psychiatry at the College of Medicine, University of Vermont, Burlington, Vermont. She earned a masters degree in social work from Bryn Mawr College, Bryn Mawr, Pennsylvania in 1963 and has done post graduate work in psychology at Syracuse University and psychiatry at Upstate Medical Center, Syracuse, New York. For the past forty five years, she has lectured extensively at colleges, universities, in the general community, and on radio and television and has served as a consultant in the areas of sexual behaviors Ms. She has co-authored a book for Macmillan Publishing Company called *Sexuality: The Human Experience*, which has also been published in Spanish and is still in print. She has published several articles in peer reviewed professional journals. Ms Golden has served as an expert witness and consultant in areas of sexuality for the past thirty years.
