Letter of Engagement/Fee Schedule – Equine Expert Consultant

Dear Attorney

This letter confirms that you have retained Wayne G. Hipsley, BSc., MSc., to work as an expert consultant in the field of horses, the science of horses and horse related activities.

Pursuant to our telephone discussions and verbal agreement, I will provide timely services to you and your client as an independent professional. In order for this to be accomplished promptly and provide your client the best service, deadlines for fulfillment are necessary as well as delineation of your expectations. Payment for the services I provide is not dependent upon my findings, nor on the outcome of the legal action, mediation, arbitration, or the amount or the terms of any settlement of the underlying legal cause, nor on any contractual arrangement between you, your client and any other person or party.

My minimum non-refundable engagement fee for services is:

Seven Hundred Fifty Dollars [\$750.00]

due at the time this agreement is signed and returned. Invoices for services performed or expenses incurred shall be charged against the engagement fee until such time as the amount of the fee is exhausted. You may not formally identify me as either a testifying or non-testifying expert until such time as the engagement fee has been paid.

1. Fees for Services

You agree to compensate expert consultant for services rendered as follows:

A. Except as outlined herein, I shall be paid by you at the rate of \$175.00 per hour for all tasks performed under this agreement, including but not limited to analysis, calculations and conclusions, preparation of reports, email preparations/communications, telephone conferences and meetings. There shall be no charge for initial consultation.
