Dr. Bardia Anvar is a board certified general surgeon with specialty certification in Wound Care by the Center of Medical Education and Testing; and Dr Anvar is the medical director of Skilled Facility Health Care Solutions, and the Skilled Wound Care Program. A graduate of the Mount Sinai School of Medicine (2002) and the University of California Irvine (2007) general surgery program, Dr. Anvar's sole practice focus is on the management of long term/chronic wounds, chronic skin disease, and geriatric feeding tube management. Dr. Anvar is the founder and director of the Skilled Wound Care Program, which provides professional wound care, skin care and feeding tube management services to over 150 skilled nursing facilities in California and Texas. He is also an expert witness for insurance groups and law firms defending nursing facilities against elder abuse cases. Dr. Anvar's book Mastery of the ABSITE is a board education manual used by top surgery programs, which include Stanford University, Cedars Sinai, and the University of California Irvine. He has been nationally recognized on a number of research projects throughout his academic career. Currently Dr. Anvar oversees the development of the Skilled Wound Care Educational Programs and Virtual Online Classroom, and he is also submitting numerous papers on Long term wound healing. Dr. Anvar is the founder and president of The College of Long Term Care, where he oversees nurse certification in Skin Wound and Ostomy Care.
